As winter weather approaches the City of Westby would like to remind residents of the City Ordinance on Snow and Ice Removal:

Sec. 6-2-9 Snow and ice removal. (g) Removal From Sidewalks. Within twenty-four (24) hours after the cessation of any fall of sleet or snow, it shall be the duty of the owners and/or the occupants of any lot or parcel of land in the City of Westby to remove, or cause to be removed, the snow or sleet from any and all sidewalks and the nearest cross-side-walks adjacent to the premises of such owner or occupant, and to keep the same free and clear of snow and ice for the full width of the sidewalk.

Keep Fire Hydrants Clear

The City of Westby asks that you keep fire hydrants clear of snow this winter so they are easily accessible in case of an emergency.
