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The Westby Police Department encourages citizens to bring forward legitimate grievances regarding misconduct by employees. We have an obligation to investigate such allegations of misconduct to protect the integrity of the agency and its employees to instill public confidence in the agency.

All complaints of misconduct will be thoroughly investigated by a supervisory member of the department. To make a complaint, you need only contact the department and explain that you wish to complain about an employee's conduct. You may do so by appearing at the department or by forwarding a written account of your complaint to the Chief of Police. If the complaint is regarding the Chief of Police, forward the written complaint to the Mayor's office. Complaints must be filed within 90 days of the incident.

Finally, malicious and deliberate false accusations are occasionally made against the agency or its employees. Knowingly filing a false report of misconduct against a law enforcement officer is a violation of the law and is punishable by a fine of up to \$10,000 pursuant to Wisconsin ss946.66.
