The Westby City Council met on Tuesday, May 18, 2021, at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Danny Helgerson presiding.

Roll call: Mark Jelinek, Ricky Rognstad, Ann Kurth, Dan Nelson (appeared via telephone), Mark Hendrickson and Sue Jacobson.

Motion by Hendrickson, seconded by Jelinek, to accept the minutes from the May 4, 2021, council meeting as typewritten. Roll call, all aye, motion carried.

Motion by Kurth, seconded by Jelinek, to suspend the rules & regulations to pay the accounts & claims. Roll call, all aye, motion carried.

Motion by Jacobson, seconded by Rognstad, to pay the accounts & claims. Roll call, all aye, motion carried.

Ron Janzen advised council of a fence to be built on lot line, rather than 3 feet off lot line. As this is not in accordance with the city's ordinance, this will be presented at the next council meeting.

Motion by Rognstad, seconded by Jelinek, to advertise for a summer helper for lawn mowing at \$12.00 per hour. Roll call, all aye, motion carried.

Motion by Jacobson, seconded by Nelson, to accept the cleaning bid from Nikki Stuber at a rate of \$16.00 per hour. Roll call, all aye, motion carried.
