Reminder to all Westby Residents and Businesses

In the event of large snowfalls in our community, please do not shovel the snow from your driveways and sidewalks back into the city streets. Our Street department spends many hours keeping our streets clean for safe travel. The City Ordinance states:

TITLE 6, Section 6-2-9:

(c) (1) *Streets and Sidewalks*. No person shall push, shove or in any way deposit any snow or ice onto any public street, alley, sidewalk or public land dedicated to public use except for parcels or lots located where existing buildings are constructed within five (5) feet of the street right-of-way and the sidewalks exist from the City right-of-way to the curb line. In such instances, the owners, occupants and/or employees of parcels or lots shall be permitted to deposit snow and ice from their sidewalks onto the public streets. Failure to remove snow and ice within twenty-four (24) hours shall also constitute a public nuisance and subject responsible persons to the penalties applicable for violation of City public nuisance ordinances.
