These Items MUST go in your REGULAR garbage

- Plastic Bags (grocery, bread bags, etc.)
- Caps and Lids (metal and plastic)
- Plastic Toys
- Laundry Baskets
- Drinking Glasses
- Window Glass
- Ceramic Mugs
- China
- Lead Collars from Wine/Champagne Bottles
- Clay Flowerpots/bowls
- Plastic Flowerpots
- Crystal
- Mirrors
- Ovenware
- Shiny Boxes
- Tissue Boxes
- Rubber
- Styrofoam
- Aerosol Cans (empty and pressure released)
- Disposable Diapers
- Aluminum Containers (TV Dinners, Pie, Cake, etc.)

LATEX paint cans must be empty and dry. Use it up, give it away, OR open can and allow to dry in sun until no longer liquid. Put out next to regular garbage with lids off. NO oil base paints.
